



Developmentally Appropriate Interest Areas: Fine Motor and Math

This training focuses on the fine motor and math interest areas, including setting up of the space and selecting materials for infants, toddlers, preschool and school age children. The Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards and the School Age Curricular Framework content areas are explored, and connections are also made to the YoungStar evaluation criteria. The critical role that teachers play will be discussed as well as teacher-child and child-child interactions.

Learning Objectives

- Explore the design of the child care environment using interest areas.
- Explore different components of the dramatic play and block interest areas.
- Shaping the environment through storage, organization, and balancing needs of the space.
- Explore the children's experiences and the role of the teacher / provider.
