



WI Model Early Learning Standards

The Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards specify developmental expectations for children from birth through entrance to first grade. The standards reflect attention to all the domains of a child's learning and development. Each domain is divided into sub-domains. Each sub-domain includes developmental expectations, program standards, performance standards, and a developmental continuum. Samples of children's behavior and adult strategies are also provided.

Learning Objectives

- Plan for the whole child using a child web, current level of functioning and goal setting.
- Understand domains of development and a developmental continuum.
- Consider the guiding principles of WMELS in everything we do.
- Use the teaching cycle to put WMELS into practice in our programs.
- Describe how WMELS can be used with families.
